

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **1. Will the papers be published? Could you share publisher details?**

The final presented papers will be published either electronically or in print media. We are working on the details and will share the same with the speakers whose papers are selected.

### **2. Can you share a format or details for submitting final Paper and Posters?**

The format for Paper submission, Presentation for Symposium and Poster submission will be uploaded to the website <http://icomosga2017.org/> by 15th July 2017.

### **3. Where can I submit my Paper/ Presentation/ Poster?**

You should have registered on the official GA website <http://icomosga2017.org/> to create an account and upload your papers/ presentations/ posters by 30<sup>th</sup> October 2017. The papers/ presentations/ posters need to be uploaded at the same location in your registered account and we will collect it <http://icomosga2017.org/call-for-papers/>. Please **do not** email the papers/ presentations/ posters. Email submissions will not be accepted.

### **4. Where can I register and pay for attending the General Assembly and Scientific Symposium?**

You will need to register in the official GA website <http://icomosga2017.org/>. There, you will find an option for registration fee payment to be paid as per details given on the website <http://icomosga2017.org/registration/>. NOTE those speaker presenters need to pay registration fee by 15<sup>th</sup> July 2017. NOTE that Early Bird Registration will close on 15th August 2017.

### **5. If I am registered and have submitted a Proposal for ST04 (Workshop/ Knowledge Cafe/ Case Study Kiosk/ Paper/ Poster) on the online portal for proposal submission, can I make the payment on the same portal?**

The online payment for registration can be made ONLY on the "registration and paper submission portal"

The online payment for registration **can not** be made on the "submission of proposals portal".

### **6. Can more than one Author be a part of Speaker Presentation?**

Only the names of Authors and Co-Authors clearly indicated in the Abstract and/ or at the time of registration can be a part of Speaker Presentation. Others are welcome to join as audience.

### **7. What is the Culture-Nature Journey (CNJ)?**

This is a global project arising from The IUCN ICOMOS collaborative 'Connecting Practice' project. See more at <https://www.iucn.org/theme/world-heritage/our-work/world-heritage-projects/connecting-nature-and-culture>

A Nature Culture Journey event was held in 2016 in conjunction with the IUCN Congress in Hawaii and resulted in the *Malama Honua* (to care for our island Earth) statement. In 2017 it is the turn for ICOMOS to host the journey and we are grateful that organisers of the **Heritage and Democracy Symposium** have offered to host it alongside the Symposium as ST04. However the journey is not restricted to the sessions in ST04 as the connection between culture and nature weaves itself through the work of many of our members and will hopefully weave through other streams.

#### **8. How are the sessions developed and run in the CNJ?**

This is a little different to the practice usually employed in ICOMOS conferences where sessions are compiled from individual paper abstract submissions. In the CNJ session Convenors are self-nominated; they are people who have collaboratively developed a series of papers or a workshop or a knowledge café around a particular subject of interest to them which fits with the CNJ objectives. The Convenors are responsible for the final form of their session and for ensuring that the participants are prepared and engaged in the session. They guide the participants in their session although the CNJ Task Force will assist in providing suggestions for collaborations across IUCN and ICOMOS.

#### **9. What form will the Knowledge Café take at the Culture-Nature Journey held in conjunction with the ICOMOS Symposium and General Assembly in New Delhi?**

Knowledge Café's will be a round table discussion between professionals interested in a particular subject. The purpose is usually to progress an existing project through dialogue or to develop a cohort of people interested in working on a new project. They will consist of around 20 participants and there will be 3-4 Knowledge Cafes running simultaneously in a large room. A list of Knowledge Cafes with available spaces will be provided on Day 1 of the Symposium so that interested delegates may select which, if any they wish to attend.

#### **10. What form will the Workshops take at the Culture-Nature Journey held in conjunction with the ICOMOS Symposium and General Assembly in New Delhi?**

The format of Workshops will vary as it is up to the Convenors to develop their Workshop. Many Workshops relate to on-going ICOMOS, IUCN, ICCROM collaborative projects and they provide an opportunity for delegates to get involved in these. The Workshops are planned for rooms that have free seating and so Convenors are asked to think about the best arrangement to encourage active participation of delegates.

#### **11. What form will the Case Study Sessions take at the Culture-Nature Journey held in conjunction with the ICOMOS Symposium and General Assembly in New Delhi?**

Case Study Sessions are run similar to Paper Sessions; however they are 8-10 short related presentations of 5-10 min in which each presenter introduces their project in a succinct manner covering Introduction, Issue, and Approach. After all the presentations there follows a group discussion chaired by the Convenor.

#### **12. What form will the Paper Sessions take at the Culture-Nature Journey held in conjunction with the ICOMOS Symposium and General Assembly in New Delhi?**

This format will be more familiar to ICOMOS conference participants. Sessions are made up of 4-6 papers of 15-20 min duration, followed by questions if time allows.
