

GRANT OF RIGHTS

ICOMOS India intends to publish a volume provisionally titled

Whereas Publication will be in accordance with all ICOMOS publishing policy, the following will apply:

1. The owner of the Work grants to ICOMOS India and ICOMOS International the following:
 - 1.1 World wide non-exclusive right for the whole term of copyright, to reproduce, translate, adapt, publish, perform, broadcast and communicate to the public, in any language and for all future editions and revisions, in printed and electronic format, the whole or any part of the Work in the Publication and to authorise other publishers or co-publishers to exercise any or all of the rights.
 - 1.2 The worldwide irrevocable right to deposit the whole or any part of the Work in its multilingual Open Access Repository in electronic form. This entails the right of access for copy, usage, distribution, adaptation, for lawful purposes within specified constraints.
2. The granting of rights as specified in paragraph 1 bears no impact upon the moral rights vested with the Author, save as wherever expressly provided.
3. The permission is granted to ICOMOS for nil fee.
4. The following credit line/ acknowledgement shall be given:

5. The permission is granted on the understanding that the publication, including its electronic version as maintained in the Open Access Repository may be distributed free of charge by ICOMOS International or ICOMOS India or its publishing partners or commercialised within ICOMOS India’s own distribution channels or those of its publishing partners.

6. The Owner of the Work certifies the following:
 - 6.1 They are the sole Copyright- Holder of the work and have full power to make this Agreement and to authorise the use of the Work as set forth in paragraph 1 above.
 - 6.2 The Work is original to them.
 - 6.3 The Work is in no way a violation or an infringement of any existing copyright or any other right granted to any other publisher and contains nothing otherwise unlawful.

7. The Owner of the work shall:
 - 7.1 for all instances, categorically and clearly identify material(s) in the Work where they do not own the copyright and give the following:
 - 7.1.1 Expressly state in writing their inability, if any, to authorise use of such materials in context of the Work as set forth in Paragraph 1 mentioned above, or
 - 7.1.2 Provide ICOMOS India, free of charge, with written permissions (using this permission agreement form) secured from rights holders of such material(s) specifically authorising its usage, as set forth above.
 - 7.2 For all instances of inclusion of Third Party Material(s), provide ICOMOS India with a copy of written permissions obtained from the respective copyright holders.

8. The Owner agrees to indemnify ICOMOS International and ICOMOS India and hold it harmless against all loss, injury, damage (including any legal costs and/ or other expenses properly incurred) occasioned to ICOMOS in consequence of any breach of above warranty.

9. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or in connection with the granting of the rights foreseen herein, shall, unless it is settled amicably, be settled by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration Rules in force by the Indian Contract Act of 1982.
